It is my honor to inform you that Saint Paul Catholic School has achieved recognition as a 2013-+2014 Indiana Four Star School. This is an accomplishment that should make you, your staff, and your school community very proud. I hope you will share the enclosed certificate of recognition with your school and community.

The IDOE established the 25th percentile cut score or combined passing percentages of English/Language Art and Mathematics as well as the percent of students passing both for all grades tested. In addition to meeting these criteria, all Four Star Schools must meet the 95 percent student participation rate. The fact that your school met these high expectations is evidence of the hard work demonstrated daily by your staff and students.

We have set aggressive goals for students, teachers, parents and administrators at the Indiana Department of Education. It is our duty to provide Hoosier students with an education that is best in the nation and on par with the most competitive countries in the world.

**Erica Wirsing**—graduated from Valparaiso University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communications. Her plans for the future are undecided.

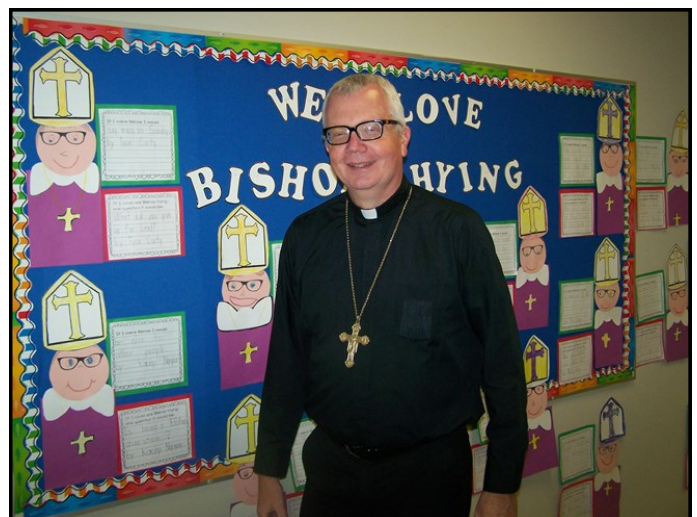
## SPCS Alumni as Royalty
